1. GOOSEN ROAD PROJECT UPDATE

We have done what we can do- Ken Morrison estimated it would be an additional \$60,000 to finish clearing out the area. As it stands now the flow of water poses no immediate threat to residents homes or neighboring roads. Future progress will remain on hold, this project is considered completed until further notice.

2. HEATHER DRIVE?

This discussion led to a clean up of the maintenance list. The board with the direction of Steve Taber went through the list line by line and updated the items that are still considered a priority for our Highway Department and which ones can be removed. (updated drainage list may be found attached)

3. 2025 BUDGET

Julie mentioned at the budget meeting that they "requested \$10,000 in funds" in hope of preventing future RFPs from having to go out to request money for drainage projects.

Questions about the tax line on the residents tax bill were brought up in regards to where the money that is pulled during tax season goes. Does it go into a separate drainage fund or if it goes into a general fund...

4. MAINTENANCE LIST

We updated the maintenance list- added onto it will be the Levitsky property that requires some sidewalk slabs to reinforce the walls along the small creek and to prevent further erosion. We as a town want to do this work now that the highway has its own excavator- it is just a matter of making it priority on the list as we come to the cooler seasons.
